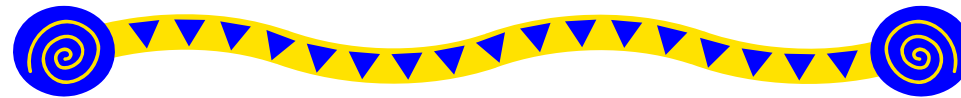

Remember that our function is to educate our members and the public on issues concerning our lovely island.

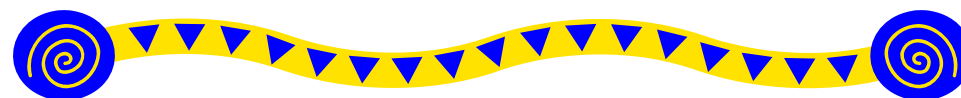
